Bishop Samuel Oluwatoyin Abayomi Fadojutimi was born into the family of Pastor Samuel and Mrs. Ruth Oluwasijuwomi Fadojutimi on March 25th, 1950.

Bishop Fadojutimi was brought up in a well groomed Christian home, his father was a renowned prophet who started missionary work at a tender age with C.A.C Worldwide from 1940 – 2001 and later rose to become a member of the Supreme Council of


He equally recognized the importance of education, hence pursuing a degree in Textile Technology. Furthermore attaining a Bachelor degree from Washington Bible School, a Master's degree in Ministry from the International Bible School in Florida where he also acquired a Doctorate degree in Christian education. He was ordained a Pastor in 1974 in C.A.C under the leadership of Baba Latunde and Pastor Udofia of blessed memory.

Prophet Obadare later instructed Bishop Fadojutimi to establish a church in Washington D.C. Thereafter, Bishop Fadojutimi travelled across the United States to establish several other C.A.C churches. During the period, he had the honour of meeting a new mentor, Apostle Cornelius Showell, who invited him into the Bible Way Organization in 1986.

#### LEADERSHIP AND CHURCH GROWTH

Sometimes we choose to lead and in other circumstances we are pushed into leadership. Sometimes leaders are born and in other situations leadership skills are acquired. It is also common for leaders to be selected or elected or appointed or ordained. Whether you choose or you are chosen to lead, how you demonstrate your leadership style will largely determine how successful those who follow you will become. Successful leaders are those who lead by the examples they set. If you hammer on virtues or techniques that you do not follow or practice yourself those who follow your leadership will fail and then wonder why. Teach and live what you teach-to be the type of leader who will stand the test of time.

It is the intention of this author to highlight the roles of the church leaders towards the numerical and spiritual growth of their assemblies in particular and the universal body of Christ in general. This paper will discuss the biblical availabilities, traits and effectiveness of church leaders.

A church leader is one who leads a church group by example (1Peter 5:3), by encouragement, by demonstration and with unconditional love. A church group may consist of large numbers or small numbers of individuals at various levels of faith and Holy Spirit. A church group may be a department, a fellowship, a committee or general assembly or congregation of individuals who worship together.

A church leader must be prepared to feed the flock of God willingly, not for filthy lucre but of a ready mind (1Peter 5:2). Contrary to the stand and expectation of a hireling, a true servant/church leader does not base his availability, performance and commitment on financial returns or other worldly rewards. A church leader as an embodiment of God's love does not exercise unquestionable authority as "being Lord over God's inheritance." (1 Peter 5:3). His expectation is the appearance of the Chief Shepherd who will come with the crown of glory that fades not.

The measure of the strength of an army captain is assessed by the number of battles he won, the volume and quality of spoils he accumulated from the battles he fought and the percentage of his soldiers who returned with him. Similarly, the effectiveness of a church leader is based on the quality of his successors and the quantity of those who become righteous by his/her leadership skills. "Those who are wise shall shine like the brightness of the firmament, and those who turn many to righteousness like the stars forever and ever" Daniel 12 verse 3. A successful church leader will raise others who step into his/her shoes.

#### PURPOSE OF CHURCH LEADERS

In any society, community or organization, the position of leaders is paramount on orderliness and justice. Church is an example of organization comprising of individuals with diverse background and upbringing but united by the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ. As such, leaders are needed for the administration of the church and for the efficient management of the organization's resources. No wonder God is the author of orderliness.

It is the expectation of the church congregations that their leaders will lead them into battle. "Nevertheless the people refused to obey the voice of Samuel; and they said, Nay; but we will have a king over us; that we also may be like all the nations, and that our king may judge us, and go out before us, and fight our battles" 1 Samuel8:19 and 20. It is true today that church growth, in all ramifications is a factor of the quality of leaders who judge the congregation without bias, fear

or favor. Churches with leaders who are endowed with spirit, wisdom and knowledge of discernment will experience sustained explosion in terms of numerical and spiritual growth over time. Worshippers will prefer to be associated and remain in churches where the leaders have the ability, anointing and the enablement to go out before the flock. Leaders who are endowed to fight the spiritual battles of life with emphasis on the ability to accurately predict the future often attract a large crowd. This is partly responsible for the growth of churches with leaders who are gifted with the spirit of prophecy. The importance of unconditional love and passion for the physical needs and welfare of the congregation by church leaders play a vital role in the growth of the church. However, the crave for prophetic utterances has partly produced thousands of individuals who shop for churches and partly motivated some Ministers who are not sure of their call to go to any length in search of whatever means to prophesy.

When leaders are gifted to stand with the members of the congregation and deliver them from the grip and claws of wicked authorities they will attract many coverage seekers to church. "Tomorrow about this time I will send thee a man out of the land of Benjamin, and thou shall anoint him to be captain over my people Israel, that he may save my people out of the hand of the Philistines; for I have looked upon my people, because their cry is come unto me" 1 Samuel 9:16. The congregation will naturally hang on or look for churches where they can be delivered from the spirits that tend to change their destiny or subject them to hardships, poverty, sickness and untimely death.

### THE TRAITS OF CHURCH LEADERS.

• Leaders Learn- Church leaders should understand that the moment they become unteachable, they lose their edge in the ministry. Leaders not only understand that they must continue

to find opportunities to learn, they crave every chance to do so. For a leader to be respected it is important that he or she is has acquired an accumulated wealth of knowledge, wisdom and experiences. Hence a leader who wants to sustain earned respect must not be tired of learning.

- Leaders Listen-They understand the difference between passive hearing and active listening. Leaders are very sensitive to verbal and non-verbal messages, but usually very slow to react or respond. The gift of discerning spirit is needed for effective communications.
- Leaders Develop Discipline- Discipline becomes the cornerstone of a good leader's life. Learning to say no when you can say yes is the road to discipline. Leaders discipline themselves to do necessary tasks even when they do not feel like doing them and avoid all avoidable at any cost. Curbing your wants makes you stronger in every aspect of your life. Church leaders have to pattern their utterances, emotions, conduct, reactions and relationships according to the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ. It takes years of consistency, transparency and self control, which are components of self discipline to instruct or advise followers to copy or emulate a leader. Apostle Paul according to 1 Corinthians chapter 4 verse 16 says "Do as I do" and Philippians Chapter 3 verse 17 says "Dear sisters and brothers pattern your lives after mine and learn from those who follow our example".
- Leaders Are Compassionate- Leaders are caring. They know that kindness trumps bad behavior and that softly spoken words are heard with understanding while yelling at peak volume simply becomes a battle of wills. Our leader, our standard and our Lord Jesus Christ for compassion agreed to come to the world in flesh and to submit himself as a sacrifice to die on the cross for the sins he did not commit.
- Leaders Don't Wait For Other People To Act- Leaders are known to take the bull by the horns. Nothing stands in the way to accomplishing the goals of dedicated leaders. Such leaders do not take or have excuses. They are individuals of action. They understand when it is good to be patient and when it is time to go forward. They understand the value of delegating. No one can do everything all of the time. Delegation is vital to great leadership. They make sure that those to whom they delegate can actually get the job done.
- Leaders Are Time Conscious-They know that time is the only commodity they cannot get more of, no matter how successful they become. So they treat it with great respect. They manage their time by planning their days with precision.
- Leaders Are Consistent- Leaders work doggedly to accomplish their goals no matter how long it takes. Persistence is key. They know that consistency and determination separate them from those who would have and those who could have but didn't.
- Leaders Focus On the Positive-A leader keeps his eye on the end results and always maintains a positive outlook, regardless of current situations. They think in terms of solutions rather than problems. Leaders understand that they are in command of their own thinking. Leaders do condemn failure but do not reject followers who failed to deliver or achieve set goals.
- Leaders Value Failure-The average leader fails many times before he or she succeeds. They are undaunted by failures and view them as golden opportunities to get closer to their goal. Leaders understand that failure is not the end of something hoped for, but a chance to learn to do it better next time. Leaders are referred to learn from what Jesus did when his disciples failed to heal the son of a man who was possessed by a spirit. According to Mark Chapter 9.

Leaders Are Authentic-They know that their clothes and cars do not make them successful as human beings. It is their actions in the world the legacy they and their true intentions that make them leaders worth following. The bible says "A good man leaves an inheritance for his children" (Proverbs 13 vs 22). Real

leaders are authentic in their approach to life and their day-to-day living. Their spoken principles reflect their actions. Great leaders have a variety of personalities and styles. They strive not to become a copy of someone else. Individuality and originality is important-to leadership.

As strong principles are important to the integrity of leadership, so is the unique vision of a leader.

• Leadership Is The Desire To Excel and To Share What Is Learned on the Path of Success-

As a leader, it is important to be generous but authentic with praise. Those learning in your footsteps need to know when they are getting it right and they need know from you. Praise should not be effusive but rather appropriate to a particular situation. Given too often it can generate a negative outcome on the long run. Not given can be discouraging and frustrating. Praise is invaluable to keep us motivated. A great leader is able to work well and easily with both fast learners and those who struggle to incorporate new ideas, techniques and principles.

#### CONCLUSION

Motivation is vital to helping followers through the learning process. It is important that followers feel comfortable asking questions and understand that their questions are relevant. Leaders do not dismiss a question as unworthy of their time, as communication is the foundation for successful leadership.

Leaders have to engage their followers in the process and keep them completely informed. When a leader holds back tiny bits of useful information to keep leadership intact, the followers may fail or the leadership becomes a suspect. True leaders maintain a mentality of abundant supplies of everything that God has created and the sky is wide enough for birds to fly without hitting or jamming each other.

#### THE WILL OF JEHOVAH (ADONAI) GOD

It is with much pleasure and joyful heart to share the little I know about "The will of the father God" by His Grace upon my life. I give total Glory and Adoration to Adonai for counting me worthy of His Calling, to be among the few that can be identified with Him. I am what I am today by His Grace, which the gate of hell cannot do anything about. I worthship Father God, for He extends His Grace toward me to be among workers in His vineyard, for the population of his kingdom through the propagation of the gospel. Without which I will be nobody, but through his special Grace, I am somebody. With that being said, I give father God total adoration and honor, in the mighty name of Jesus Christ.

The word of God, according to the book of Isaiah 53 vs. 10 says, "yet it was the Lord's will to crush him and cause to suffer, and though the Lord makes his life a guilt offering, he will see his offspring and prolong his days, and the will of the Lord will prosper in his hand." (NIV) The Bible refers to the will of God in three different senses. "The Will of God" is another way of saying "The Law of God." According to Psalm 40 vs. 8 says, "I desire to do your will, Oh my God, your law is within my heart." (NIV) Apostle Paul considers knowing God's law to be synonymous with knowing God's will (Romans 2 vs. 17-18). In other words, God instructs us in the way that he wants us to walk; the law may properly be called "The Will of God." "Law" essentially means "instruction", which includes the whole word of God.

Secondly, "The Will of God" is also used to designate anything that God expressly desires; this may properly be called God's "Perfect Will." It is God's revealed "Will" that everyone should be saved. 1 Timothy 2 vs. 4 says, "Who wants all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth" (NIV), and that no saved believer should fall from grace. This truth does not mean that everyone will be saved, but only that God desires the salvation of everyone".

"The will of God" may refer to what God permits or allows to happen, even though he does not specifically desire it to happen; for this reason, it may properly be called "God's Permissive Will." Indeed, much that happens in the world is contrary to God's perfect will (for example: sin, lust, violence, hatred, hard-heartedness and so on), yet He permits evil to continue for the time being. For example, the decision of many people to remain unsaved and thus lost for all eternity is permitted by God, for God does not force saving faith on those who refuse to accept His son's salvation. Similarly, many troubles and evil that befall a person in life are permitted by God. (God knows about everything). 1 Peter 4 vs. 19 says, "So then, those who suffer according to God's will should commit themselves to their faithful creator and continue to do good," (NIV) but they are not necessarily God's desire or His ultimate will for those people.

The Bible's teaching about the will of God expresses more than mere doctrine; it intersects with our lives as believers on everyday basis. For instance, we must learn what God's "Will" is. That is, his perfect will as revealed in the scripture. Because the days we live are evil, and we must understand what "The Lord's will is". Ephesians 5 vs. 17 says, "Therefore, do not be foolish, but understand what the Lord's will is." (NIV) Once we know from the revealed "Will of God", how He desires us to live as believers, we must commit ourselves to do His "Will". Psalm 143 vs. 10 says, "Teach me to do your will, for you are my God; may your good spirit lead me on level ground" (NIV), which indicates that the Psalmist is essentially asking God for the ability to live a righteous and holy life. In the same way, Apostle Paul expects the Thessalonian Christians to follow God's will by avoiding sexual immorality and by living a life of holiness.

#### WHAT IS EVANGELISM?

The dictionary definition of evangelism is preaching the Christian Gospel or to the practice of relaying information about a particular set of beliefs to others with the object of converting them to Christianity.

People who specialize in evangelism are known as evangelists. Churches that encourage evangelism are known as evangelistic or evangelist churches. The bible itself does not use the word evangelism, the word evangelist can be found used in the book of Acts 21:8, Ephesians 4:11, and 2 Timothy 4:5

The message of Evangelism is to tell of God's good news, the gospel. The message of evangelism is called many things in the Bible. It has been called the "gospel of God" in (Rom. 1: 1; 1 Thess. 2: 2, 8, 9; and in 1 Tim. 1:11) it has also been called the "gospel of Christ of Christ" (Rom. t5:19; 1 Cor. 9:12; Gal. 1:7) "gospel of the grace of God" (Acts 20:24) because it is the medium of God's grace to man; the "gospel of peace" (Eph. 6:15) because through it man makes peace with both God and self; and the "gospel of your salvation" (Eph. 1:13) because it brings salvation home to us. It is this gospel and this alone which must always be the message of evangelism.

The Purpose to reconcile men to God. The greatest need man has is to be reconciled to God. The word "reconcile" means to change from enmity to friendship. The one thing that stands between man and God is sin, "for all have sinned, and fall short of the glory of God" (Rom. 3:23), and "the wages of sin is death" (Rom. 6: 23). God who did no wrong and has no need of being reconciled to man took the initial step to bring man, the offender, back to him. He "demonstrates his own love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us" (Rom. 5:8).

Christ's death not only abolished the law which was contrary to us, but it made it possible for us to be reconciled unto God in one body (Eph. 2:13-16). The "word of the cross" (1 Cor. 1:18) is the "word of reconciliation" (2 Cor. 5:19) by which sinful men are brought back into friendship with God. The process of telling the "word of reconciliation" is the "ministry of reconciliation" (2 Cor. 5:18). Thus, to reconcile men to God by "the word of the cross" is the primary purpose of evangelism.

To save self. When God called Ezekiel to be a watchman to the house of Israel He told him his blood would be required at his hand if he failed to warn the wicked, or the righteous man who turned to iniquity. Only by giving them adequate warning could he deliver his own soul. (Ezek. 3:16-21).

In principle, at least, what was true of Ezekiel is true of every Christian. The souls of the lost whom we fail to warn will be required at our hand. Every person is responsible to the limit of his possibilities. We must reach as many as we can. "How many" we shall be able to save will be determined by our abilities and our opportunities, and how well we meet up to our responsibility. How many of us can say, with Paul, "I am pure

from the blood of all men" (Acts 20:27)? One thing for sure, only by "holding forth the word of life" (Phil. 2:16) can we deliver both ourselves and those that hear us (1 Tim. 4:16). Christians cannot save themselves without saving others. Our own salvation, then, is a very important purpose of evangelism.

#### WHAT IS TRUTH?

Pilate during the trial of Our Lord Jesus Christ in reaction to Jesus, asked the question; what is the truth? The circumstances of the trial did not allow Jesus to teach Pilate about the truth as he had taught His disciples. In John 18, 37; "Pilate therefore said unto him, Art thou a king then? Jesus answered; Thou sayest that I am a king. To this end was I born, and for this cause came I into the world, that I should bear witness unto the truth. Every one that is of the truth heareth my voice."

The response of Pilate was prompt as we read in verse 38; where "Pilate saith unto him, What is truth? And when he had said this, he went out again unto the Jews, and saith unto them, I find in him no fault at all." Pilate did not wait enough for Jesus to elaborate and give an adequate answer to the question he asked Jesus. However, the Jews have been able to confront Jesus with the same question.

According to the dictionary, truth has a variety of meanings and it is mainly in consonance with fact or reality. Fact is some event that has really occurred or is actually the case and reality in philosophy is the state of thing as they actually exist, rather than as they may appear or might be imagined. Truth in other context also means fidelity to an original or to a standard or ideal. Generally, in common usage truth is the act of constancy, sincerity of action or character. The opposite of truth is falsehood. The concept of truth has been a subject of study, discussions and debates by philosophers and religious scholars through the ages as can be seen from the encounter between Pilate and Our Lord Jesus Christ. The judicial establishments of the world depend upon the concept, to dispense justice in activities of everyday life. It is also a subject of discussion in scientific endeavor and law. As a matter of fact, institutions of higher learning all over the world and different religious organizations regard the concept as one of their doctrines for spiritual, moral and social values in society and the kingdom to come. Academic freedom stems from freedom to make inquiry, find out the facts as they are and freely disseminate the findings without any sanctions whatsoever. No wonder Jesus in John 8: 32 said; "And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free"

Various theories and views of truth continue to be debated among scholars and philosopher. Truth can be subjective, objective, relative or absolute, but our Lord Jesus Christ was talking about the absolute truth when he declared in John 8; 32 that "And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free." He also declared in John 14; 6, "Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me"; and in verse 17 he declared that "Even the Spirit of truth; whom the world cannot receive, because it seeth him not,

neither knoweth him: but ye know him; for he dwelleth with you, and shall be in you."

The promise of the Holy Spirit as we know it is the spirit of truth. In Acts 4:1-5, Ananias, with Sapphira his wife, sold one of their possessions and conspired to withhold the some part of the proceeds of their property from the Apostles, but the spirit of truth revealed this to Peter and the couple bore the consequences of their falsehood with their demise.

As followers of Jesus Christ Our Lord and savior, we must imbibe His character of truthfulness at all times at home, at our working places and in the community. This will distinguish us from the world as true disciples of Jesus. It is written in John1:17 that; "For the law was given by Moses, but grace and truth came by Jesus Christ." God through Moses set out the ten commandments as laws that God's people must obey, but Jesus came to give us grace and truth about our Father in heaven. Jesus in clarifying the intention of God condensed the ten commandments of His Father into two; namely:

"Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with

all thy mind. This is the first and great commandment. And the second is like unto it, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself."-Matthews 22:37-39.

As we celebrate another El-Bethel let us remember the truth that Jesus spoke to His disciples and therefore to us in John 16: 7-15:


"Nevertheless I tell you the truth; It is expedient for you that I go away: for if I go not away, the Comforter will not come unto you; but if I depart, I will send him unto you.

Reasons why people are afraid to step out in faith



It is the woman that unites her family/home. A woman has a lot of responsibilities where her family is concerned. A woman runs her home with 'WISDOM'. (Book of Esther).




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
